
EXERCISE III

EXERCISE IV

LET'S INVESTIGATE



Holmes sent five of his detective friends to keep control on a gang of bank robbers. Each detective must keep an eye on a person with a particular mark, and each must stand on a particular stop on the London Metropolitan line. From the clues below, can you figure out what distinguishing feature each detective will be looking out for and where they have been sent?



1. Wiggins is at Farringdon Street but his 'mark' doesn't have a scar on his chin.
2. The robber in the crumpled hat is being watched by the boy at portland Road. The boy watching the suspect with red hair is at King's Cross but is not called Jimmy.
3. Tommy, who is watching the criminal wearing trousers rolled up at the knee, is at the station immediately after Jimmy.

(In this grid the detectives are marked as D1, D2 etc. The streets' names sign the metro line stop. On the horizontal line you will find the bank robbers' distinguishing features.)
