EVOLUTION OF HANDBALL

1.....

It is a racket sport played by either two players (singles) or two pairs (doubles). It is played on a court divided by a net with racquets and a shuttlecock.

3.....

A team sport, usually played outdoors, on a pitch, with a round ball, a goal, with two teams of 11 players, and a goal keeper. You play a game of it or a match.

5.....

It is usually played by individuals, it is played on a course, using several types of clubs and a ball. You play a game of it or a round of it.

6.....

A team sport, played outdoors, on a pitch, with an oval ball, and two teams of 15 players. You play a game of it or a match.

7.....

It is a racquet sport played by either two players (singles) or two pairs (doubles). It is played on a court divided by a net, with rackets and a ball. You play a game of it or a match.
